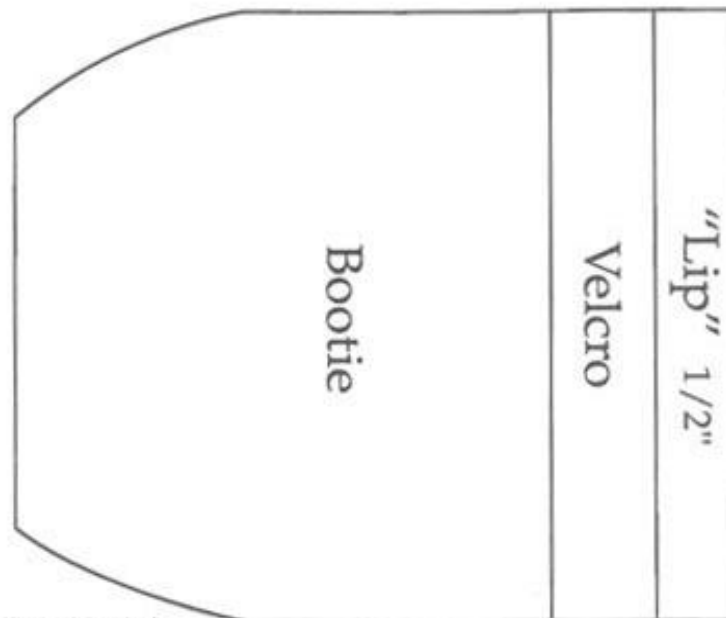


Making Booties



I. Pieces Needed

- A. Bootie - size of pattern
- B. Velcro - 1 1/2 inches of Hook side, 2 inches of loop side
- C. Elastic - 3 inches

II. Sewing

A. Cut out Bootie

1. Use polar fleece or trigger cloth
2. Sew smooth seams
3. Make relatively tight stitches - stitch twice
4. **NO HOLES! THIS IS VERY IMPORTANT!**
5. Trim seams and threads
6. Turn right side out
7. "Quality Control" - Check very carefully for holes

B. Velcro & Elastic

1. When placing velcro on bootie, leave 1/2 " lip" above velcro
2. Sew one piece velcro to elastic
3. Attach loop, "gripper", piece of velcro to one side of bootie
4. Attach other piece of velcro & elastic to other side of bootie
 - a. May glue velcro to material first
 - b. Then sew
 - c. Insert 3 fingers, fasten velcro. Bootie should fit snugly.

NOTE: DO NOT sew anything into seams!!!!
